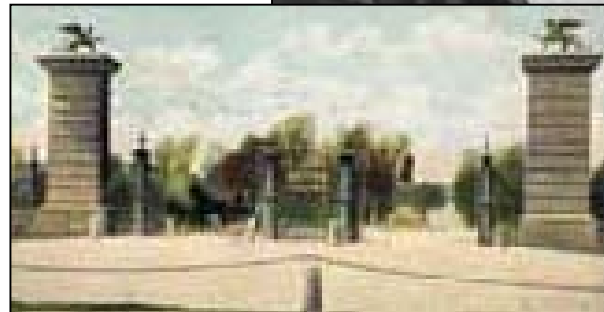

- In 1868, Henry Shaw conveyed lands to the City of St. Louis to create Tower Grove Park.
- A total of 289 acres, containing various landscapes, unique shelters and numerous statues, Tower Grove Park is considered one of the finest Victorian era parks in North America.
- Tower Grove Park is one of only four parks nationwide, to be classified as a National Historic Landmark.

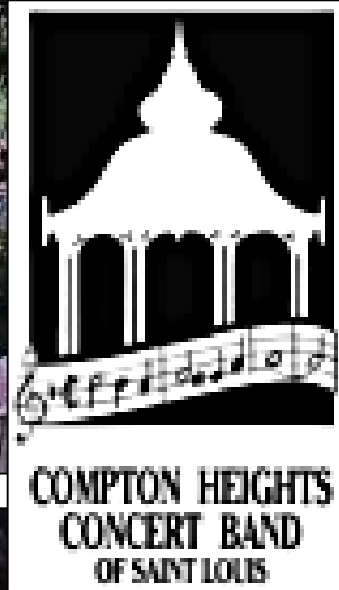
